

The Old School Campsite

Terms and Conditions

General

Bookings are nominative and non-transferable.

In the event of a complaint, please speak to reception immediately. Complaints which are not brought to the management's attention during your stay cannot be dealt with once you have left the site.

Quiet hours must be respected between **10:30 p.m. and 8 a.m.**

Radio, music and TV players must be kept at a low volume. Car doors and boots must be closed quietly. The management reserves the right to deny access or terminate the stay of those guests whose behaviour is deemed unsuitable. No refunds will be offered.

Arrivals and departures

Late arrivals must notify the park as soon as possible. Your booking will be held for 24 hours. After this period the management reserves the right to re let your unit.

No refunds/discounts for inclement weather, late arrivals or early departures.

Units will be allocated on arrival.

Permitted arrival/departure time

Camping and touring

Arrive: 12 p.m. – 9 p.m.

Depart: 11 a.m.

On-site accommodation

Arrive: 12 p.m. – 9 p.m.

Depart: 11 a.m.

Changes to your holiday

Bookings cannot be amended within 7 day(s) of arrival.

Modifications are subject to a £10.00 fee.

Admission

Admission is only permitted after registering at reception.

All guests spending the night at the park must present their ID at the reception desk and sign registration forms.

Under 18s must be accompanied by their parents or legal guardians.

Pitches

You must follow the management directives when pitching your tent/unit and related equipment.

Reception

Reception is unmanned after 6 p.m.. Please inform the site while on your way there should you expect to arrive after this time, so that the team can provide information about your unit/pitch.

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on leads and supervised at all times.

Guide dogs are allowed on site free of charge.

The site does not accept breeds/crossbreeds listed in the Dangerous Dogs Act.

Extras

A charge of £0.50 applies for the use of shower.

Motorbike(s) can be brought instead of the car(s) included.

Safety

Barbecues are permitted but must be raised off the ground and attended by an adult at all times.

Firearms are not permitted.
Open fires are prohibited.

Vehicles

Only one car/bike is allowed per pitch.

Visitors

Visitors must leave the premises by 10 p.m..
Visitors must register at reception and pay their fee.
Visitors' cars are not permitted on site.

Payment

A 15% non-refundable deposit is payable now. The Old School Campsite will **debit the balance from your card** 1 week before arrival, or if the arrival date is sooner than 1 week then the balance will be taken immediately.

You can also opt to pay the full amount at the time of your booking.
